Application Instructions

The purpose of the Trust is to assist young people who have shown potential to be community leaders to attend courses and/or events to develop their leadership skills further. For example, (but not limited to), Outward Bound, Inspiring Stories Future Leaders program, Duke of Edinburgh Award, etc. In particular, the Trust will:

- Contribute to the cost of transport, accommodation, and fees to attend leadership courses or events.
- Provide other support and assistance consistent with this charitable purpose.
- Courses should be established and with a proven track record.

To be eligible for a grant applicants should:

- be in the age group of 16 to 25 years.
- have shown that they have volunteered in meaningful projects in the community.
- be residents of Otago, Canterbury, or Southland.

Applicants **must** also be New Zealand citizens or permanent residents.

If you meet the above criteria and wish to make an application for funds, please fill out the application form below. We need your full name and date of birth, your residential address, your contact phone number and email address.

Distributions will be allocated three times per year, in March, July, and November. To be eligible for a distribution, applications must be received prior to 1st February, 1st of June or 1st of October. In the weeks prior to allocation, the trustees will verify the details in the application and contact the applicant for additional information if required. All applicants will be notified 1st week in March, 1st week in July, or 1st week in November with the funds available the following week or when required.

Please provide details of the course or event you wish to attend. The course should be well established with a good track record for assisting young people to develop. Please include a contact or link where we can get further information if required. We also need details of your expected costs including travel, accommodation, specialist equipment, and fees.

To help the trustees make a decision on which applications are successful and for how much, we would like to know what other funding you have secured or hope to get. This should also include how much of your own funds will be committed.

Finally, tell us more about yourself. What have you been involved with in the community? What are your interests and passions? Why do you want to attend this course or event? What are your aims for the future? please also include two referees with their contact details. The trustees are looking to support a person that helps others, is committed to doing good within the community and shows potential to be a future leader in their chose field.

The amount of funds allocated to each successful applicant will depend on their commitment to the community, relevance of the course or event to leadership, and the effort the applicant has gone to in securing other funding. For larger cost items, the trustees would like to see quotes and/or proof of bookings. At the conclusion of the course or event, the trustees want to receive copies of certificates gained plus receipts for items over \$100
